- Is a low-income individual, first generation college student or has a disability.

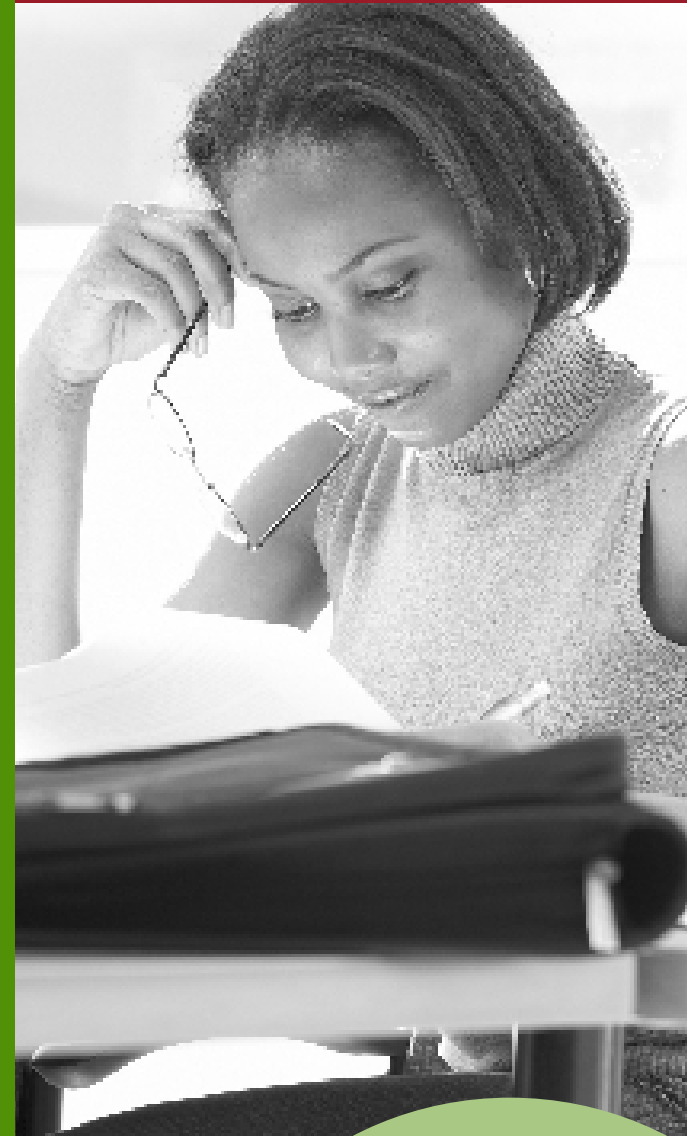
# What services will be available to students?
