

**STARK STATE COLLEGE
ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP
2010 - 2011**

ELIGIBILITY	Restricted to high school seniors planning to enroll as full-time students at Stark State College and who have a minimum grade point average of 3.00. Students are encouraged to file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Award recipients must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA to remain eligible for the scholarship in the second semester.
SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT	The amount of each scholarship may vary, but it is intended to defray the cost of instructional and general fees for the freshman year.
SELECTION	The Stark State College Scholarship Committee will determine selection of recipients. The committee will consider grade point average, school and community activities, academic background, ACT scores or the Compass Placement scores.
DEADLINE FOR FILING	<u>FEBRUARY 1</u> . If all scholarships are not awarded, the selection process will continue until July 1 on a first-come, first-serve basis.
NOTICE OF AWARD	Successful candidates who meet the February 1 deadline date should receive notice of award by March 1.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. The candidate shall complete the attached application form.
2. The candidate shall return the completed application to the high school guidance office.
3. The guidance office must attach the counselor's recommendation and the candidate's high school transcripts to the scholarship application. Applications without transcripts attached will not be considered. Forward the completed packet to:
