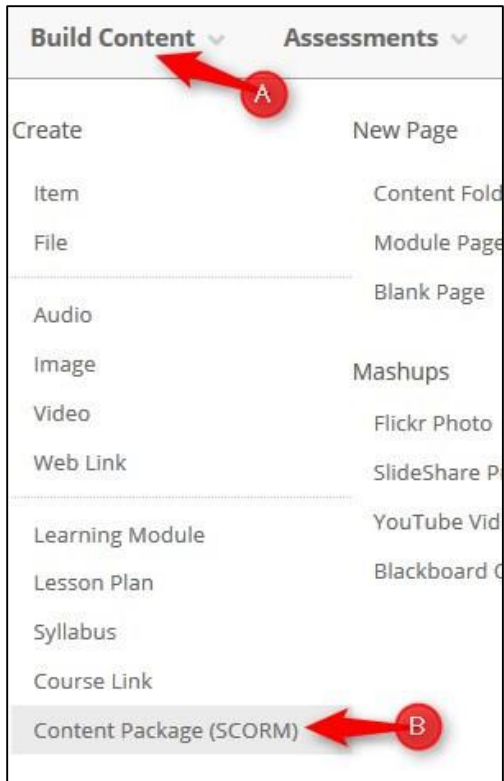


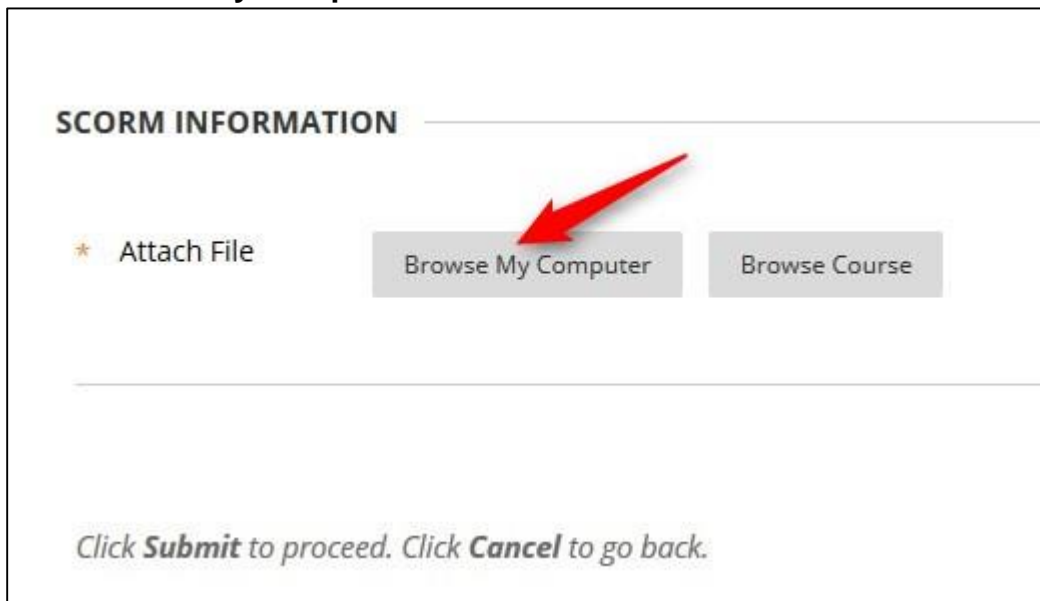
Adding a SCORM Package

Directions:

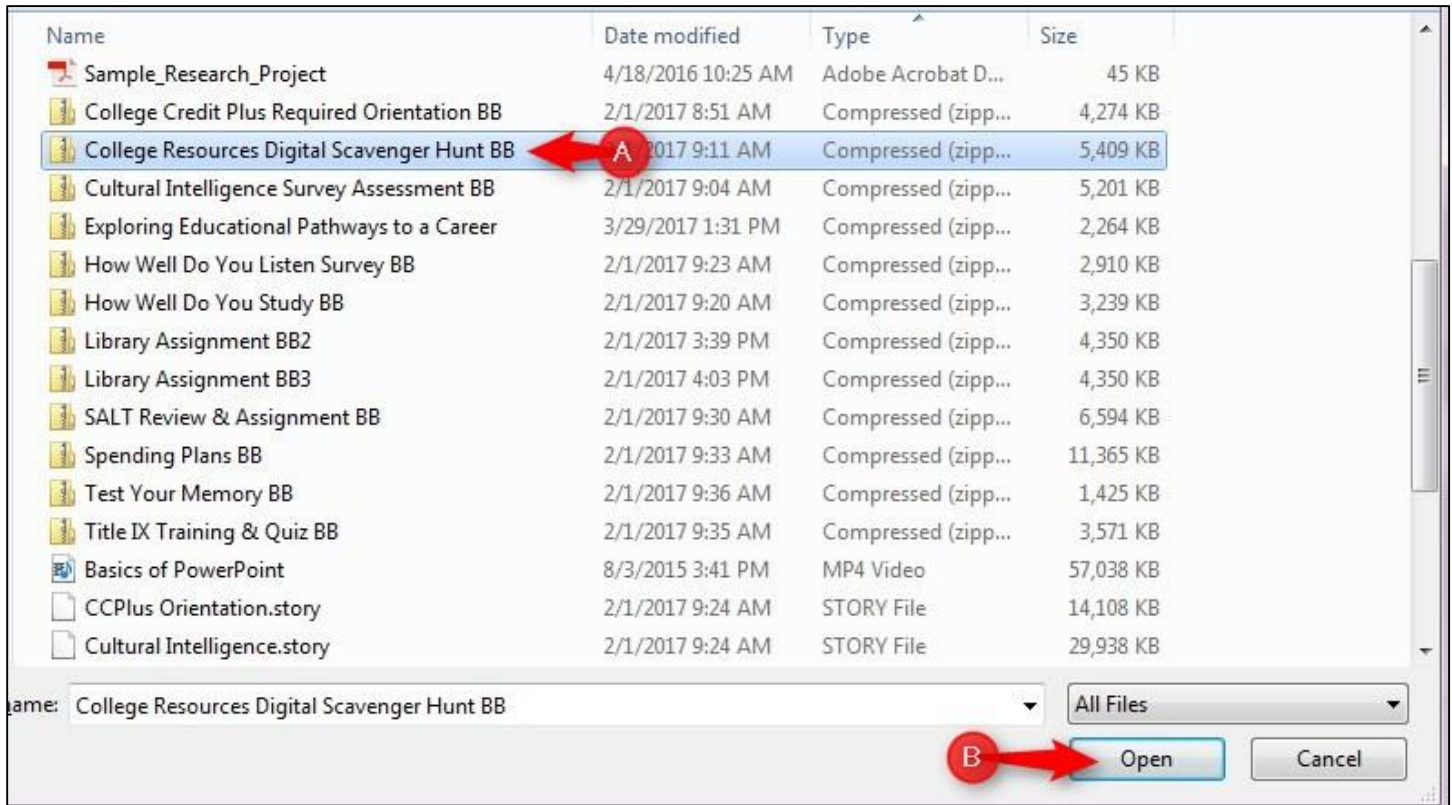
1. Click **Build Content**
2. Click **Content Package (SCORM)**



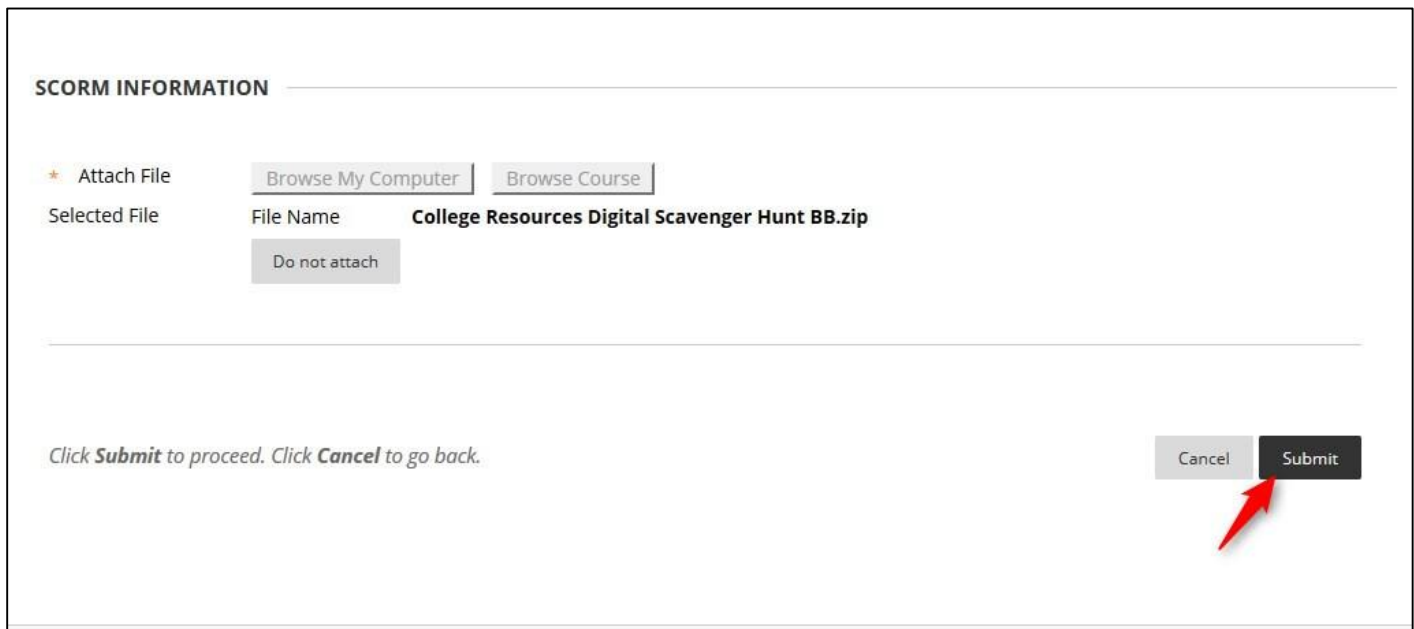
3. Click **Browse My Computer**.



4. Select your package, and then click **Open**




5. Click **Submit**. Be Patient. The upload may take several seconds.



- 6. Check the Title and description. The title will automatically populate from the scorm package. You can add a description as necessary.
